

Niels Martin Sunesen:

I am running for National Treasurer of the European Youth Denmark.



I have been a member of our organisation for around 3 years now, in our North department located in Aalborg. For the last six months I have been the political vice president of EUN, a position that I have been very glad for. When I am not working on making new events and connections for EUN, I attend a master course on Aalborg University in European Studies, and I am 1,5 years away from finishing it. I have a bachelor's in politics and Administrations.

Experiences: I have previously worked as a treasurer in another political youth organisation, Frit Forum Aalborg, where I worked with a lot of the same issues, that we are facing with in European Youth Denmark. Since that was at a local level, I know that the work assignments might be somewhat different from what I could potentially encounter as a treasurer on a national level. But I am confident that I will be up for the task and that I will be able to help improve the communications between the national and the local levels and thereby, hopefully, allow us to create even better events and spread our message in Denmark.

I have also taken part in courses in bookkeeping and how to make a budget for an organisation. This was done in collaboration with Arbejdernes Landsbank in Aalborg.

Creating a network of our treasurers: (I want to create a network, between all the treasurers in our organisation. This should help us streamline the economic process in our organisation and thereby make it easier for us to know what we have available in funds. This should also help, in making it easier for new treasurers, to quicker get into their new role, so as little time as possible is used for being confused, because of a lack of knowledge. This will hopefully enable us, to get out and reach even more people in Denmark, because our organisation will be functioning even better.

Why am I running for this seat: I have always been very interested in how organisations work, and one of the more important areas for an organisation, maybe not the lifeblood but the hands then, is the treasury.

The amount of funds that we have will always play a huge part, in what we as an organisation can do, because if we want to go beyond social media and have our members out in the streets and cities of Denmark, then we are going to need a little pocket money.

Now some might question whether I have the time, to actually be our national treasurer, since I am also the political Vice President of EUN. And that is a fair question to ask, and one in which I with confidence can say yes. I do believe that I can take care of both positions, and the reason for that is simple. I have people who I know will help and support me. People that can help me with reaching out in Northern Jutland, to all the different organisations and help me with getting events set up, both in and outside of Aalborg. Because no one in this organisation can nor should work alone.
